

President's Message

2013 National Show and Sale! Over 200 Lincolns were entered in the show held in conjunction with the "Big E" (Eastern States Exposition) at West Springfield Massachusetts on Saturday, September 22 in Mallary Arena. This probably was the largest Lincoln show ever held in North America! David Cook (OH) had the honors to judge the show - it was a big job and a long day, but in his words "the quality of the show was outstanding"! The top quality Lincolns in the sale sold well, but there were not enough buyers present to sustain a sale of over 30 head of good sheep. Ten white Lincoln lots averaged \$560 and 17 natural colored lots averaged \$440.

2014 National Show and Sale will be held in conjunction with the Great Lakes All-Breeds event in Wooster, Ohio on May 24-25. Banner Sales will be managing the event and entries will be due March 15. This will be an opportunity to enter ewe lamb show prospects for the Lincoln Futurity (see results of last year in this newsletter).

Why Pay Dues? 1) The printed and web page directory is the first reason: those that paid their 2013 dues were included in the attached directory (junior members contact information is not put on the web for safety reasons). 2) Secondly is voting rights: whether at a biennial membership meeting or a ballot by mail, only members with paid dues are allowed to vote.

Officers and Board Members

Elected: It was decided at the biennial membership meeting at the "Big E" to hold a mail ballot election. The registrar (Milo, IA) conducted the election and a 60 day period to receive ballots is required by our constitution beginning the date that the ballots were mailed. Sixty-five ballots (2013 dues paid members) were sent and 47 (72% return rate) were returned within the 60 day period (2/3 ballots must be returned

for a valid election per our constitution). Re-elected were president Brian Larson (MI), secretary/treasurer Debbie Vanderwende (DE) and east midwest director Diane Klingelhofer (MD). New vice president is Emmaline Long (NY) and new west coast director is Christiane Payton (OR). 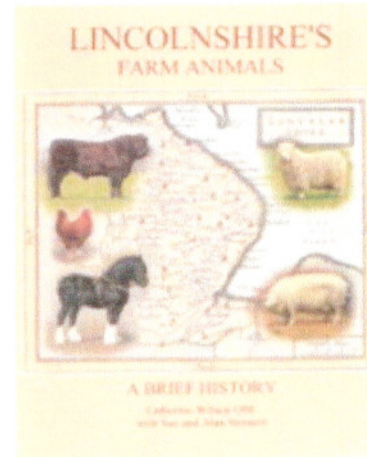
Do you want to take a trip to see UK Lincolns! Preliminary plans include a group departure flight from a US origin airport Friday evening, July 25th and return on Friday August 1st, 2014. A highlight will be the final show of the Lincoln Longwool show season to be held at the show grounds in Heckington, Lincolnshire on Sunday, July 27th. Also that day is their national sale and shear-off where all full-fleeced sheep shown are shorn and fleeces judged. Also on the itinerary are visits to half a dozen breeders, the largest public UK sheep market, the UK wool marketing authority and historical sites in mid-England. An initial cost estimate for planning purposes is \$1,900 per person (double occupancy) which includes airfare from and back to a US origin airport and bed & breakfast lodgings. Not included are rental cars, admissions, and other meals. Riverbend Travel, Hastings MI will be handling all travel itineraries. Reduced fares for folks to fly to the US origin airport have been negotiated. If you are at the least interested, contact Brian Larson. Jim Lein 1939 - 2013



James M. Lein, 73, Arlington area farmer and sheep breeder for 48 years, died August 23, 2013, at University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics, Iowa City, Iowa of hypersensitivity pneumonitis.

Jim was born November 18, 1939, the son of Minard (MJ) and Mabelle (Wolfe) Lein in Des Moines, Iowa. He was baptized at St. John's Lutheran Church, Des Moines, Iowa. The family moved to Graettinger,

Iowa where he completed eleventh grade and then graduated from Valley High School, West Des Moines, Iowa following the family's move back to the Des Moines area. He attended Iowa State University in Ames and was a veteran of the United States Army where he served as a Missile Engineer with the 166th Ordnance Corps. On July 23, 1967, he married Donna (Hay) Scherman at St. Mark's Lutheran in West Des Moines. The couple farmed in the Arlington area and raised purebred sheep (Suffolk, Corriedale, Lincoln) which they have done until the present.

Jim's childhood and youth were spent with much emphasis on the 4-H program and specifically competition with Holstein dairy cattle at local, regional and state fairs. He continued his love of livestock and competition at fairs and consistently won champion awards in several sheep breeds. The Lein family earned Premier Exhibitor award over 30 times at midwest state fairs including the 2013 Iowa State Fair. The 2013 event was the first Iowa state fair that Jim missed in over 70 years due to his health. In 1971, he was chosen Iowa State Fair Cookout King with his recipe and presentation of "Daddy's Drumsticks."

In the 1970's, he organized the RCO (Reroute Crude Oil) group of concerned farmers, soil scientists, engineers and a legal team who successfully changed the course of an oil pipeline that could have endangered the aquifer under northeast Iowa's rich farmland.

He served on Camp EWALU board at Strawberry Point for many years, guiding financial decisions and updating their Stone Center, where the couple celebrated their 25th wedding anniversary. Jim served on church councils at Zion Lutheran in Oelwein, Iowa and Zion Lutheran in West Union, Iowa.

Jim was appointed to the Iowa Sheep and Wool Promotion Board, the Iowa Department of Agriculture's Economic Development Board and

was chairman of the Iowa Agriculture Products Advisory Council. He also served on the American Sheep Industry Wool Council. In 1988 he represented the US in a delegation to promote sheep and wool in Russia.

Jim was nationally regarded wool expert and understood the existing marketing system - what worked and what did not. He worked on several projects in attempts to open market doors for Lincoln wool domestically and abroad. Jim and Donna also identified and developed individual Lincoln ewes that naturally cycled in the spring which resulted in a significant flock of natural fall lambing ewes. Jim was also an expert shearer, devoting much effort to teaching others proper shearing and wool handling techniques.

In 1991, Jim and Donna received the Farm Bureau Outstanding Service to Agriculture for Fayette County of which he was a member for 48 years. The Leins were selected for the Iowa Farm Environmental Leader Award in 2012 to recognize their efforts as farmers to improve and protect the state's resources. Jim was known to say: "tractors are green, pickups are red." He took pride in the restoration of his 1970 GMC 3/4 ton pickup with a stock rack. His famous red pickup led his funeral procession.

Jim is survived by his wife, Donna of Arlington, Iowa; three daughters, Shelley (Dean C. Paul) Lein of Vernon Hills, Illinois, Sarah (F. Joseph Umana) Lein of Apex, North Carolina, Susan Lein of Berea, Kentucky; one son, Nathan (Jamie) Lein of Oelwein; four grandchildren, Whitney and William Paul, Hans and Reuben Umana. He was preceded in death by his parents and a son, David.

Donna and Nathan are continuing with the Lincoln and Corriedale flocks. Nathan and his wife, Jaime, also have vertically integrated the flocks into a business venture called "Big Boy Meats".

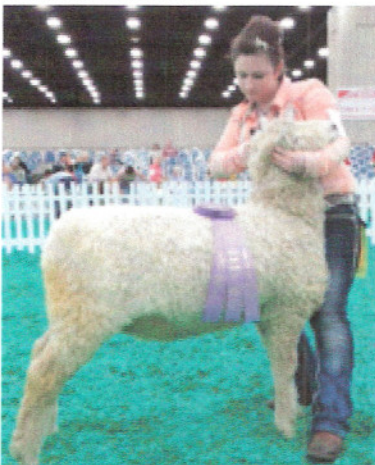
